



Local Foundation Invests \$450,000 into Teulon Medical Facilities in 2024!

The Teulon Healthcare Foundation is a volunteer organization that is passionate about supporting and enhancing local healthcare services and facilities. The Foundation has been providing the citizens of Teulon and the surrounding RMs of Armstrong, Rockwood, St Andrews, St Laurent and Woodlands with the opportunity to support local healthcare services since 1993.

In 2024, the Foundation funded significant renovations to local healthcare facilities.

Improvements included:

- Adding 3 new rooms in the Teulon Medical Clinic: 1 new exam room and 2 new consultation rooms.
- Adding new diagnostic equipment.
- Fully renovating the Hunter Memorial Hospital's treatment and procedure room.
- Installing overhead rail lift systems into Goodwin Lodge, Hunter Memorial and the new treatment and procedure room.

These improvements would not have happened without the generous support of our donors over the years!

Speciality Equipment

The Foundation funded a Barrier-Free Exam Table for the new clinic exam room. This exam table provides patients with mobility challenges easier and more comfortable access. The Barrier-Free Exam Table also allows the physician to conduct a more comprehensive exam.



Overhead Patient Lifts

The Foundation funded 12 overhead patient lifts throughout the facilities. These lifts are the safest and most effective way to move patients and residents that have mobility issues. The lifts also enhance patient comfort. In addition, ceiling lift systems reduce workload, strain, exertion and injuries to local healthcare staff leading to greater worker safety and satisfaction.

Scholarships & Bursaries




